## MMSA Logo/Design Guidelines

All art work must fit in an area that is 6” wide and 6” high

- All art work must be black and white.
- Avoid very intricate, detailed, lightly shaded, small-scale drawings – these do not reproduce well.
- All art work must be original. No clip art, for example.
- The title, “Innovate” should be included in the design. The title may be hand written or typed.
- Be sure to include name, grade, school and city on the back or on an attached piece of paper.
- One entry per student.
